POLICY

The undergraduate curriculum is planned under four major heads

- 1. Core courses, are mandatory courses in the subject of specialization within an undergraduate program.
- 2. Complementary courses mean a course that would enrich the study of core courses.
- 3. Common courses come under the category of English and Additional language
- 4. Open courses refers to an optional course which the student is free to take at his/her will. Open course shall be a non-major elective course offered by the Departments other than the parent Department.
- 5. Add-on courses are courses designed specifically by the college to bridge the skill gap between the university curriculum and the requirements in the employment sector.
